- Fair Market and Centro East Rezoning Cases- both projects are requesting a zoning change and Neighborhood Plan Amendment change to increase from 60 to 85 ft. (modifying ECC neighborhood plan, FLUM, and the Saltillo TOD). The Planning Commission will hear both cases on June 8 and City Council will hear both cases on July 29th.
 - o **Fair Market at 1100 E. 5th St.** proposes a \$1 million fee in lieu for affordable housing and improvements in the Medina St. ROW in exchange for increase to 85-feet, replacing existing Quonset hut buildings.
 - Centro East at 6th and Comal proposes to include affordable housing in their apartment mix in exchange for increase to 85-feet.

- Traffic calming initiatives on Comal St.- Carmen Schofield
- Terrazas Library Beautification Project- Willow Street residents, Terrazas Library Manager Danny Walker, and Charles Loosen of the CoA's Homeless Outreach Team will discuss the beautification project and timeline. Discussion re: possible ECCNPCT and ECC community co-sponsorship of the beautification project for long-term management and sustainability.

- Scoot Inn- requesting support for lifting the limitation on maximum number of shows per month over the next year, June 1, 2021 to June 1, 2022, to rebuild post-COVID. Lifting the restriction on the maximum number of shows per month would enable Scoot more flexibility to book shows (with shows on any given day) while staying within the agreed upon 84 shows per year maximum.
 - Under such an arrangement, Scoot Inn would continue to provide a monthly calendar of events the month prior and promises to continue to be great neighbors by maintaining sound curfews/dB limits as stated in the neighborhood agreement.
- Team use of 'Slack' platform- discuss structure, protocols, best practices, and training.
